So, how do I get started on planning a paper ballot vote in my community?

- 1 Contact your regional community organizer to get the latest information and supplies you'll need for your vote (contact info for each is below).
- 2 Create a committee of people to work on this together; don't try to do it all yourself. Ask your friends and colleagues to help!
- 3 Decide if you are going to hold a special ballot vote event or add it on to another already scheduled event.
- 4 Pick a place, date and time for your event.
- 5 Publicize the event (using the networks you use everyday is the best start). Utilize Facebook, Twitter, put up posters, your local newspaper and radio station, insert in church bulletins, etc.
